The Petition of James Lake of the Township
of Earnest Town humbly sheweth
that your Petitioner joined the Royal Militia
in General Burgoyne's Army in the year seventy
seven and enlisted as a private Soldier in Colonel
Peters Gore and was taken prisoner the same year
and remained a Prisoner till peace which was in
eighty three and removed to this Province in the year
Ninety three and remained here ever since and has
only received two hundred Acres of land from the Crown
Wherefore your Petitioner prays that
your Excellency may be pleased to grant him
one Hundred Acres more to put him upon an equal
footing of that description and permit Mr John
Butler of the Town of York to be his Agent locate the
same and take out the Deed when completed

January 24th
1809

And as in Duty bound will ever pray
